Work, Play, Love 2019 Trip

Things to bring with you:

- Passport and/or Green Card if you require one.
- Check with your cell phone carrier to get coverage if needed. Kim will have her texting working. Your WIFI may not work at the Hogar but texting normally does. When we get to town/hotel your WIFI will work.
- Make sure if you bring US \$ that is in perfect condition. You can get \$ exchanged at airport/ ATM Antigua/ or get it at your bank at home. Check for best rates at your bank.
- Visa and Cash are best. There is a service charge for most of us using Visa or ATM cards. Check with your bank.
- Shuttle pick up: Kim or taxi driver with your name on sign will be there. Please make sure you text Kim when you get on your last leg of flight so we know you are on time to pick you up.

Things to also Consider Bringing:

- Crisp US Currency – NO tears – it will not be accepted anywhere you go.
- Camera & phone (keep close to body at ALL times)
- Bug spray/ after bug spray
- Hats (keep hair up as much as possible because of lice)
- Recommend coconut oil and tea tree oil/ neem oil as a preventative for lice.
- Lice kit – if you want to bring it. (Kim has been on 30 trips and has only had lice once).
- Thieves Oil or Neem is good as an insect repellent for your bedding and rooms. Great to bring with you on any travels. Use a few drops in a spray bottle.
- Umbrella if coming on rainy season (May-Oct is rainy season)
- Wipes/ hand sanitizer
- Flash light



- Light rain coat for rainy season
- Hats for sunny weather
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Tennis shoes (the terrain is varied – wear something comfortable)
- Flip-Flops &/or Sandals for hanging out
- Warmer clothes for at night
- Walking shoes & Comfy shoes (there are many step hills at the Hogar)
- Medicine you may need (Advil, allergy..)
- Tote bag or backpack to carry your personal items to the Hogar & in Antigua.
- Protein bars
- Any other snacks you enjoy

Clothing:

- Casual stuff: jeans, capri pants, hiking pants, shorts, long skirts, comfy shoes, cute sundresses...
**Remember Ladies to cover things up at the Hogar 😊*
ie: tank tops to be longer and higher, shorts to be close to knee level, basically nothing to tight and low.
 Keep your expensive jewelry at home.
- Weather is about 65-80 daytime / 55-60 at night

Things to bring for the kids:

Lice shampoo, multivitamins for kids , probiotics for kids, used tennis shoes or new. All sizes boys or girls.
